Recommended Courses for Majors Planning to Transfer to WVU

Students planning to transfer to West Virginia University from anywhere within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS) should complete the following courses at the VCCS level to ensure timely degree completion. Courses in black are strongly recommended—students who do not complete these courses may require an additional year due to course sequencing issues. Courses in blue are encouraged—students who do not complete these courses will not be able to complete their degree in the minimum number of semesters.

Students who complete the Associate of Art or Associate of Science degree will satisfy all of the WVU general education program except for the junior/senior seminar (WES 300).
